Section 1. Section 220-44 is amended as follows:

A. Following the first reference to "Church Street" under the heading "Name of Street", and following the reference to "East" under the heading "Side" and then under the heading "Location", delete the words "From U.S. Route 343 to a point 600 feet south of the intersection of Church Street and Alden Place" and replace with the words "From the south side of the driveway of 100 Church Street to a point 50 feet south therefrom, and from a point 100 feet north of Manzi Drive to U.S. Route 343".

Section 2. If any section of this local law shall be held unconstitutional, invalid, or ineffective, in whole or in part, such determination shall not be deemed to affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder of this local law.

Section 3. This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with this state's Secretary of State as prescribed by law.

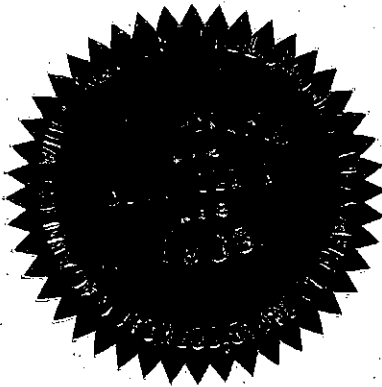

RESOLUTION

Trustee Collopy, offered the following resolution, which was seconded by Trustee Brown, who moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, a local law was introduced as Local Law No. 2 of 2015, entitled A LOCAL LAW OF THE VILLAGE OF MILLBROOK, DUTCHESS COUNTY, NEW YORK TO AMEND CHAPTER 220 OF THE VILLAGE CODE ENTITLED "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC" TO MODIFY AND EXTEND THE NO PARKING ZONE ON CHURCH STREET; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing in relation to said local law was held on June 23, 2015 at 7:00 p.m., Prevailing Time, and then adjourned and continued on July 14, July 28 and August 11, 2015, at 7:00 p.m., Prevailing Time; and

WHEREAS; notice of said public hearing was given pursuant to the terms and provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York; and

WHEREAS, said local law has been on the desks of the members of the Board of Trustees for the Village of Millbrook for at least seven (7) days, exclusive of Sunday.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Millbrook that the Village Code is amended to read as follows:

Section 1. Section 220-44 is amended as follows:

A. Following the first reference to "Church Street" under the heading "**Name of Street**", and following the reference to "East" under the heading "**Side**" and then under the heading "**Location**", delete the words "From U.S. Route 343 to a point 600 feet south of the intersection of Church Street and Alden Place" and replace with the words "From the south side of the driveway of 100 Church Street to a point 50 feet south therefrom , and from a point 100 feet north of Manzi Drive to U.S. Route 343".

Section 2. If any section of this local law shall be held unconstitutional, invalid, or ineffective, in whole or in part, such determination shall not be deemed to affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder of this local law.

Section 3. This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with this state's Secretary of State as prescribed by law.

RESOLVED that the Village Clerk shall file a certified original of this local law in the office of the Village Clerk and one (1) certified copy in the Office of the Secretary of State, State of New York, such certified copy to have attached thereto a certificate that it contains the correct text of the enactment of this local law.
