WE HEREBY SUBMIT SPECIFICATIONS AND ESTIMATES FOR:

RE-CONSTRUCTION OF TWO (2) ALL-WEATHER TENNIS COURTS 120' X 108'

1. The exact location of the 120'X 108' court area will remain the same.
2. **An Access** roadway to the court area will be constructed. The fence fabric will be removed **and replaced by Sport Tech (see option for new fence)**
3. The **existing court planarity will remain the same, there will be no difference in slope.**
4. The existing court surface (asphalt) will be removed and legally discarded off site, the courts will be re-graded with a LASER GRADER and compacted, stone base will be installed as needed
5. The **net posts footings will be removed and discarded off site, new net posts #1107**, are positioned according to U. S. T. A. specifications. The foundation will be 3'X3'X3' and filled with concrete one (1") inch from surface course.
5. **Center strap anchors, #1045**, will be positioned and set in concrete footings 1'X1'X1'.
6. **At this point the courts are ready to pave**

7. A **2-1/2 binder course of asphalt** will be installed over the courts with a LASER PAVER and compacted.
8. A **1&1/2" surface course of hot plant asphalt (TYPE 7F)** will be constructed over the leveling course with a **Laser Controlled automated paver** and compacted by a roller.
9. Prior to application of color surface, the court surface will be flooded with water and allowed to drain. Any **depressions** will be filled and leveled with Deco-Patch binder. If the standing water does not cover a five-cent piece, it is within tolerance and will evaporate within a reasonable time.
10. **Two (2) coats** of Acrylic Resurfacer is used to seal entire court area.
11. **One coat of color, #900-27, Texture course Winter Green with sand** will be applied over entire court area. (or choice of color)
12. **One (1) coat of finish coat Winter Green** will be applied over entire court area.(Or choice of color)
13. **White Line Paint** will be used to paint 2" playing lines. The lines will be masked out, then One (1) coat of clear will be applied to assure a sharp line. Atop of clear, Two (2) coats of white line paint will be applied by brush.
14. The **net, #1701, is put up and center strap, #1070, is attached.**

DRAWINGS, SURVEYOR COSTS, LANDSCAPING.

New Trash Can Proposal:

I have been doing a lot of research on our village trash issue. I have submitted my Big Belly proposal to the Tribute Gardens Trust in hopes they might help offset the cost of this new system. Unfortunately they only make these decisions twice a year. (July/Dec) Knowing this I am proposing we wait to purchase trash cans. This will give us more time to make the right decision for a sustainable long term solution for our village.

I have talked to Welsh, George Whale III, Mike Herzog, Gary Cefferri and several other business owners. We all agree we have a problem that needs to be resolved. Big Belly would like to do a conference call with the Board of Trustees to explain how their system works. I think if you agree to this we should include Welsh and George Whalen in this conference call.

I have also done research on other trash receptacles we could purchase but I think it would be best to wait until the following list below is done. This will give us more time to make an informed decision.

This is what I propose doing in the meantime:

1. Update Village Code
 2. Reduce number of trash cans provided for the public
 - Remove all trash cans on side streets
 - Provide 4/6 trash cans along Franklin Ave in well-lit areas and not by curbs.
 - Have Village Board committed to cleaning existing trash cans and helping relocate before May 15th. Store extra trash cans in case we find areas that need double receptacles. Place bins in high traffic areas and getting business owners involved in monitoring trash overflow.
 - Organize a committee to oversee bins for the 2018 season.
 - Overflow/Cleanliness
 - Bins not being used – relocate
 - Place in well-lit areas
 - Illegal Dumping of Household trash – report to authorities

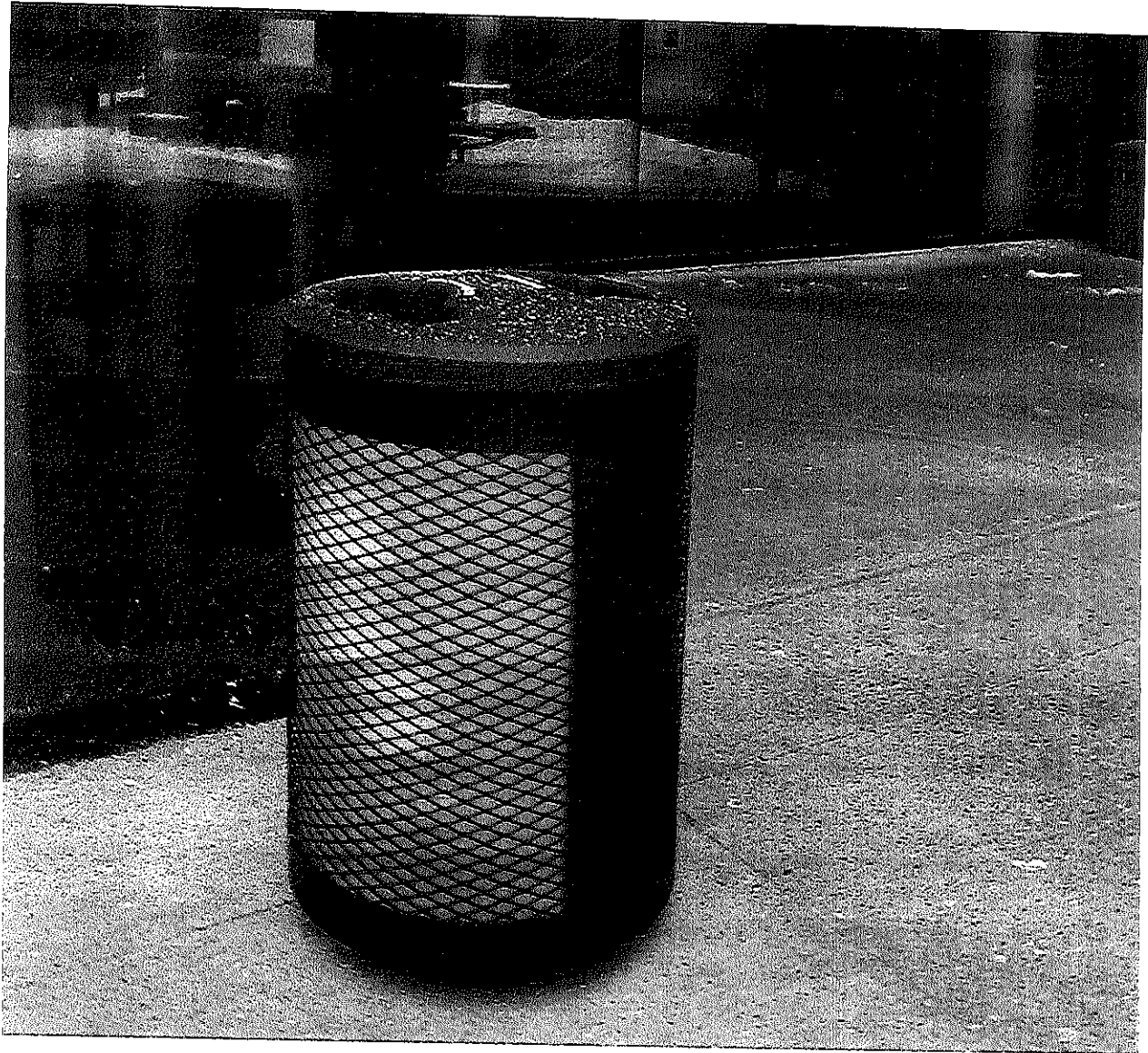

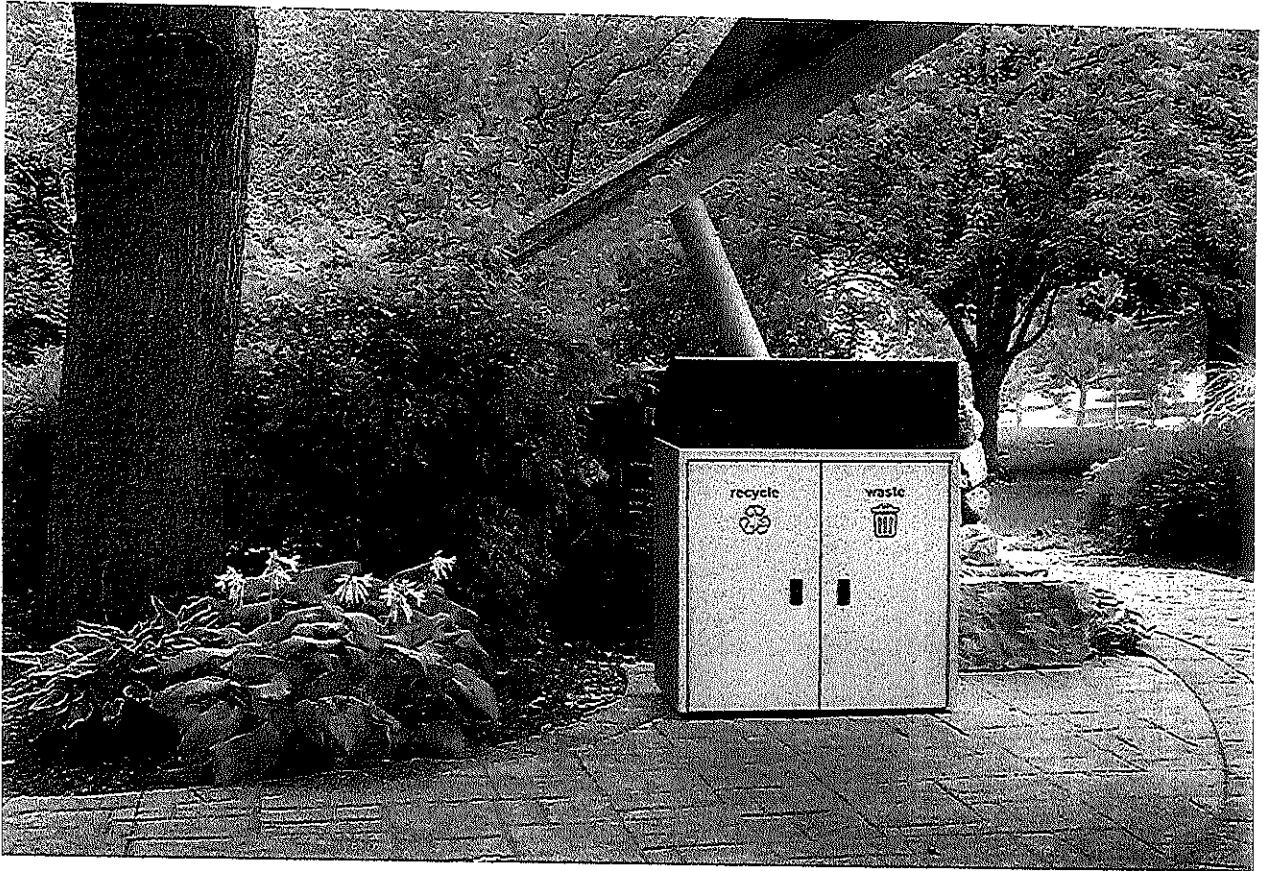

Chapter 136. LITTERING

Article I. General Provisions

§ 136-1. Definitions.

Editor's Note: Added at time of adoption of Code (see Ch. 1, General Provisions, Art. I).
As used in this article, the following terms shall have the meanings indicated:

LITTER

Garbage, rubbish, ~~and~~ refuse and tires, furniture, white goods, construction and demolition debris, household waste and all other waste materials which, if thrown or deposited as herein prohibited, tend to create a danger to public health, safety and welfare or render streets, private grounds or public places unsightly.

§ 136-2. Prohibited acts.

No person shall sweep, throw, cast, drop, put or place or, having accidentally dropped, fail to pick up any bag, bottle, bottle cap, box, container, garbage, paper, piece of paper, wrapper or any other trash or litter, in or upon any public street, place, park or building, except in receptacles provided for such purposes, or to permit any person under his or her control or employ to do the same.

§ 136-5. Penalties for offenses.

Editor's Note: Amended at time of adoption of Code (see Ch. 1, General Provisions, Art. I).
Each violation of any provision of this article shall constitute a violation pursuant to the Penal Law, punishable, upon conviction, as provided in Chapter 1, General Provisions, Article III.

136-2.

Public trashcans are not receptacles for private household waste. Using public trash cans instead of designated garbage collection service will result in fines or penalties.

136-3.

Landlords should provide receptacles from designated garbage collection service for their tenants. As an alternative, landlords who collect and transport their own trash by using the Town of Washington Transfer Station need to provide transfer passes upon request of code enforcement officer.

190-6.

If a special event takes place (Community Day, Fireman's Parade, private permit event) an extra garbage pick up at the expense of the permit holder should be scheduled unless the event sponsor takes responsibility for carry out garbage.
