Dear Tim:

It is our understanding that you and Mr. McGrane are responsible for reporting on issues related to the Bennett College section of the Village.

To that end we feel that we must jointly bring to your attention the condition of two dangerous areas on Exmoore Lane. They have in fact been deteriorating since last reported two years ago, to the point of now becoming an accident waiting to happen. While the Bennett Common Road access with its multilayers and uneven pavement is difficult to navigate, Exmoore Lane and the original premise of the turnaround are a danger to the cars, emergency vehicles and Cardinal Hayes vehicles, as well as their passengers. A broken axle, loosened engine block, swerving off at the curve are likely possibilities, given the road's extraordinary ruts and poor grading. With the upcoming winter ice and snow, they will only become more of a hazard. Note that this is the only access to the house for the residents or 17 Exmoore Lane and the Cardinal Hayes Habilitation Facility for severely injured children.

Regarding the turnaround, it is so severely in disrepair that it is only in segments. As a result, there is little solid roadway for emergency vehicles in case of fire, ambulance and general safety needs for the non ambulatory patients of the Cardinal Hayes building and Lane residents for which it was built. Access to the fire hydrants is also an issue.

Although the serious situation of Exmoore was informally addressed a few weeks ago, the response was that there are no funds nor time available for any repairs. We are therefor writing with the details of this important issue, in the hopes that you will aid us in addressing and solving this urgent situation. We remain at your disposal to meet and further discuss, and appreciate your timely response and assistance in this matter.

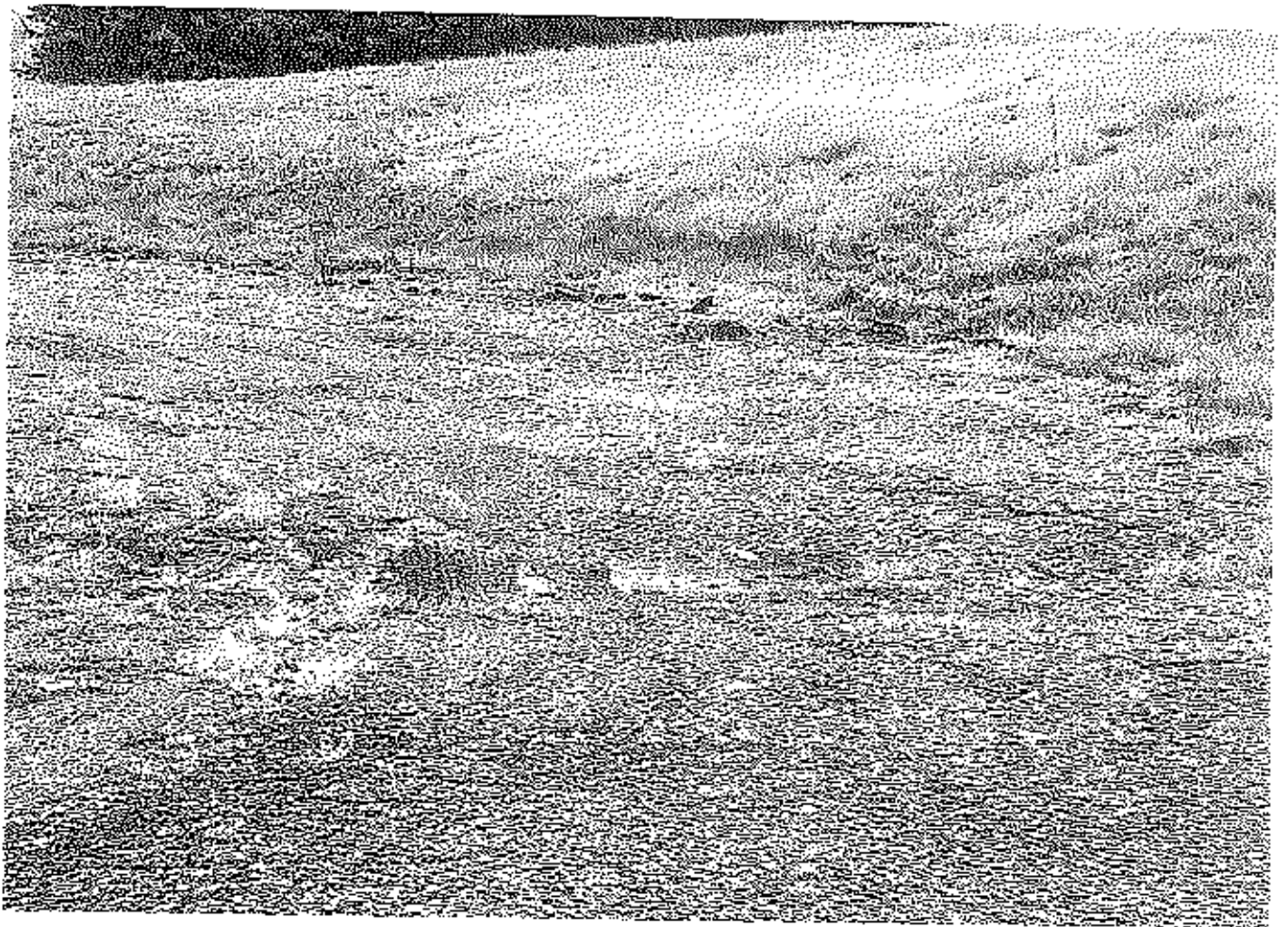

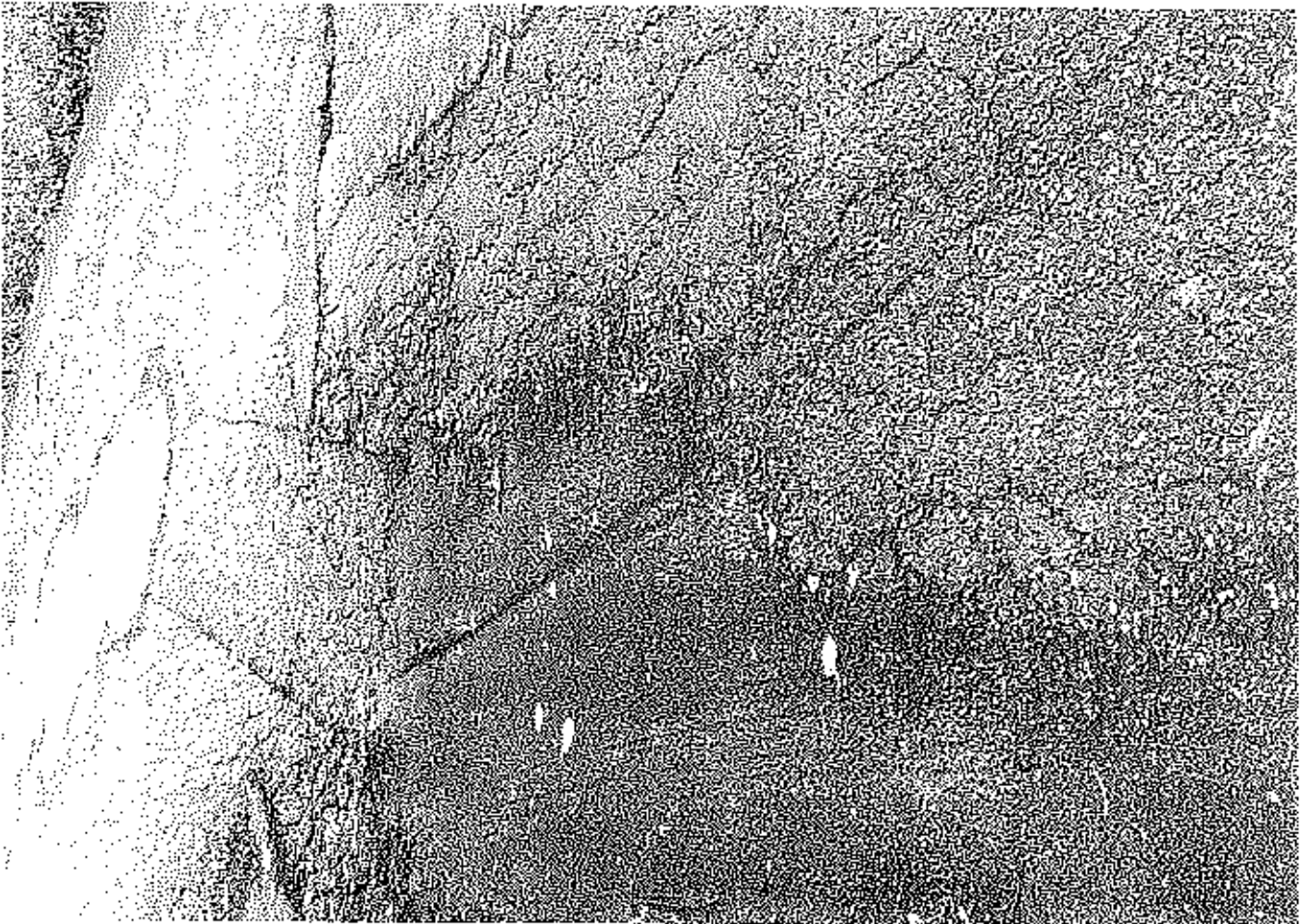
