APRIL 1<sup>ST</sup> - MAY 31<sup>ST</sup>

Brush pick-up is a service provided to Village Residents from April 1st to May 31st and **additional pick-up days** during the summer months which include the **second Monday of July, August & September**.

Brush pick-up **DOES NOT INCLUDE** yard clearing, tree removal or leaf pick-up. Fines up to \$150 may be assessed by the DPW Supervisor if these items are out for pick-up. (Leaf pick-up begins October 1st)

### WATER BILL INFORMATION

With the recent outbreak of COVID-19 Governor, Andrew M. Cuomo, signed into law amendments to the Public Service Law (PSL) that ordered a moratorium on terminations and disconnections of residential electricity, gas, steam, telephone, and water customers during the COVID-19 state of emergency. These amendments provide that residential & small business customers, in certain circumstances, may be eligible for additional protections from terminations or disconnections if the residential customer had "a change in financial circumstances due to the COVID-19 state of emergency."

For those who are behind in payment for the above reason, Village of Millbrook will provide a payment agreement, without the requirement of a down payment, late fees, or penalties. If you are experiencing financial circumstance's due to COVID-19, please contact our office to arrange a payment arrangement for your water service. You may also send a written letter to our office requesting a payment arrangement.
