Brush Pick-Up Days

July 13th, August 10th & September 14th

During the months of July, August & September you may **place brush curbside (10) days prior to the second Monday** of that month.

Brush pick-up **DOES NOT INCLUDE** yard clearing, tree removal or leaf pick-up. Fines up to \$150 may be assessed by the DPW Supervisor if these items are out for pick-up. (Leaf pick-up begins October 1st)

- You will be able to come in to browse, check out items, use the computers by appointment, and make copies. **The study areas will not be available at this time.**
- We are limiting our children's room to two families at a time to encourage social distancing.
