

RESOLUTION No. 010 of 2020

Introducing Local Law Amending Sections 212-2 Through 212-6 of Chapter 212 of the Village Code Regarding the Shade Tree Commission

At a meeting of the Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Millbrook (“Village Board”), held at the Village of Millbrook Village Hall on the 25th day of August, 2020, at 6:30 p.m., Village Deputy Mayor, Tim Collopy, called the meeting to order, and Trustee Herzog, seconded by Deputy Mayor Collopy, moved the following resolution, to introduce the following proposed local law, to be known as Proposed Local Law No. 6 of 2020, entitled “A Local Law Replacing Sections 212-2 through 212-6 of Chapter 212 of the Village of Millbrook Village Code with a single Section 212-2 providing that the governing rules of the Shade Tree Commission shall be contained in Bylaws within the Policies of the Village.”

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Millbrook as follows:

Section 1. Legislative intent:

Chapter 212 of the Village of Millbrook Village Code establishes a Shade Tree Commission and provides the authority under which the Shade Tree Commission operates. That authority includes the terms of office, compensation, duties and responsibilities and rules and regulations of the members of the Shade Tree Commission. The Village Board intends to amend Chapter 212 of the Village Code to provide that the composition of and the rules governing the Shade Tree Commission shall be maintained in the policies of the Village of Millbrook under Shade Tree Commission Bylaws.

Section 2. Sections 212-2 through 212-6 inclusive of the existing Chapter 212 of the Village Code of the Village of Millbrook, are hereby repealed and substituted in their entirety with a new Section 212-2 which shall contain the following language.

“§212-2 There is hereby created and established a Shade Tree Commission for the Village of Millbrook, New York. The composition of that Commission and the Bylaws which govern it shall be found in the Policies of the Village of Millbrook under Shade Tree Commission Bylaws.”

Section 3. The existing Sections 212-7 through 212-13 of Chapter 212 of the Village Code shall be renumbered accordingly following the substitution of the new Section 212-2 for the existing Sections 212-2 through 212-6.

Section 4. This local law shall take effect as of the date of filing with the New York Secretary of State.

Trustee Herzog advised the Board of Trustees that, pursuant to the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York, it will be necessary to hold a public hearing upon this proposed local law. Trustee Herzog offered the following resolution, which was seconded by Deputy Mayor Collopy, who moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, on August 25, 2020, Trustee Herzog has introduced this local law for the Village of Millbrook, to be known as “A Local Law Replacing Sections 212-2 through 212-6 of Chapter 212 of the Village of Millbrook Village Code with a single Section 212-2 providing that the governing rules of the Shade Tree Commission shall be contained in Bylaws within the Policies of the Village.”

RESOLVED, that a public hearing be held in relation to the proposed local law as set forth in the form of notice, hereinafter provided, at which hearing parties in interest and citizens shall have an opportunity to be heard, to be held at the Village Hall, 35 Merritt Avenue, Millbrook, New York, on September 8th, 2020 at 6:30 o’clock, p.m., Prevailing Time, and that notice of said meeting shall be published in the official newspaper of general circulation in the Village of Millbrook, by the Village Clerk, at least five (5) days before such hearing and that such notice shall be in the following form:




